Position Summary:

The EMT / AEMT Instructor is responsible for delivering high-quality education and training to students enrolled in **Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)**, **Advanced EMT (AEMT)**, and **AEMT Cardiac** programs. Instruction will be provided in accordance with the **National EMS Education Standards**, **National Scope of Practice Model**, and **Rhode Island Department of Health EMS Regulations**. This role includes both classroom-based lectures and hands-on psychomotor skills training, with a focus on preparing students for certification and real-world emergency medical response.

Key Responsibilities:

- Deliver engaging lectures and facilitate discussions on EMT and AEMT-level topics, including cardiac care.
- Lead psychomotor skills labs and scenario-based training sessions for both basic and advanced EMS procedures.
- Ensure all instruction aligns with national and state EMS standards and regulatory requirements.
- Evaluate student performance through written exams, practical assessments, and continuous feedback.
- Maintain accurate records of student attendance, progress, and certification status.
- Collaborate with fellow instructors and program coordinators to ensure curriculum consistency and instructional quality.
- Participate in continuing education and professional development activities.
- Promote excellence in EMS education and uphold the mission and values of the organization.



Required Qualifications:

- Minimum of **3 years of field experience** in Emergency Medical Services.
- Current **NREMT Certification**.
- Licensed or certified as an **EMT, AEMT, AEMT Cardiac, Paramedic in the State of Rhode Island**.
- Strong knowledge of EMS protocols, patient care standards, and instructional techniques relevant to both EMT and AEMT levels.
- All instructors will be required to obtain AHA BLS Provider Instructor and NAEMSE Skills Instructor Certification within 1-year of employment.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Current **American Heart Association (AHA) Instructor Certification** (e.g., BLS).
- Prior teaching or training experience in EMS or healthcare settings.
- Familiarity with adult learning principles and instructional technology.
